




#### **NATIONAL WEBINAR**








### Department of Political Science organises national webinar





### National Training Program on Intellectual Property Rights and Patenting






## National Conference on New Education Policy 2020: Socio-Economic & Political Implications

### **Constitutional Obligations Addresses: Right To Education**










## Faculty Enrichment Programme on "Towards Enhanced Digitalization: Mentoring the Mentors"








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#### **COVID Vaccination Drive**
