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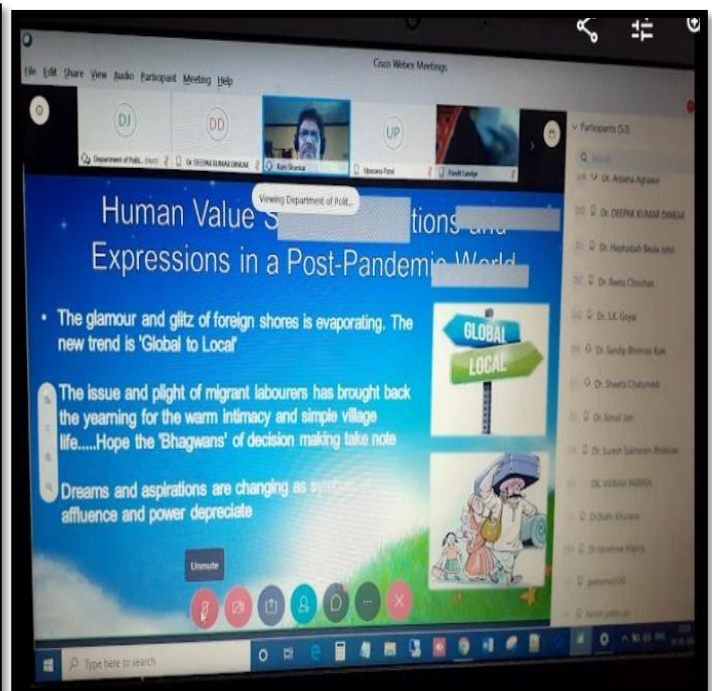
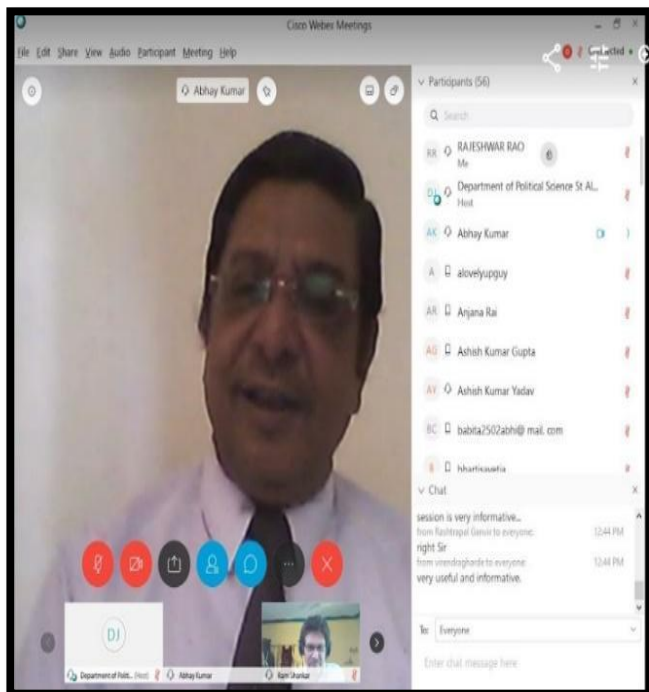
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NATIONAL WEBINAR

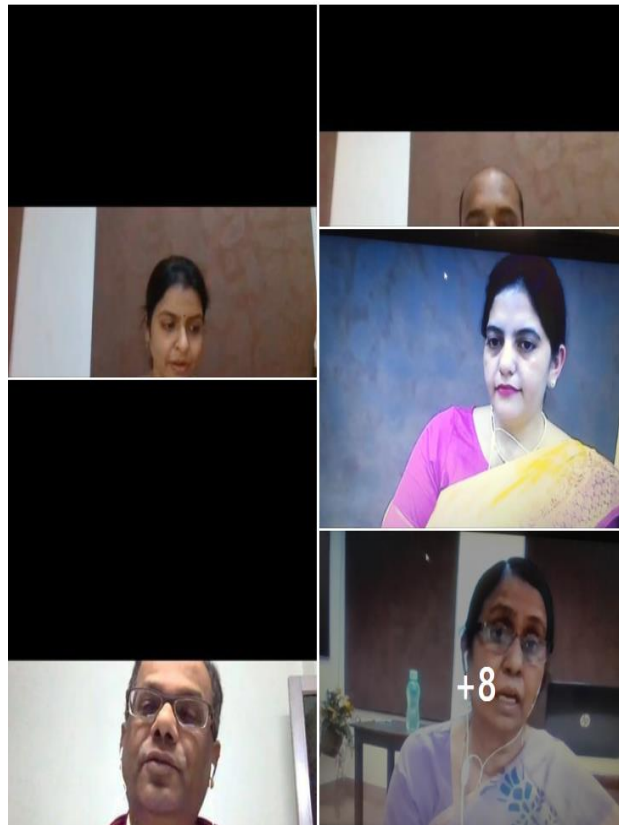

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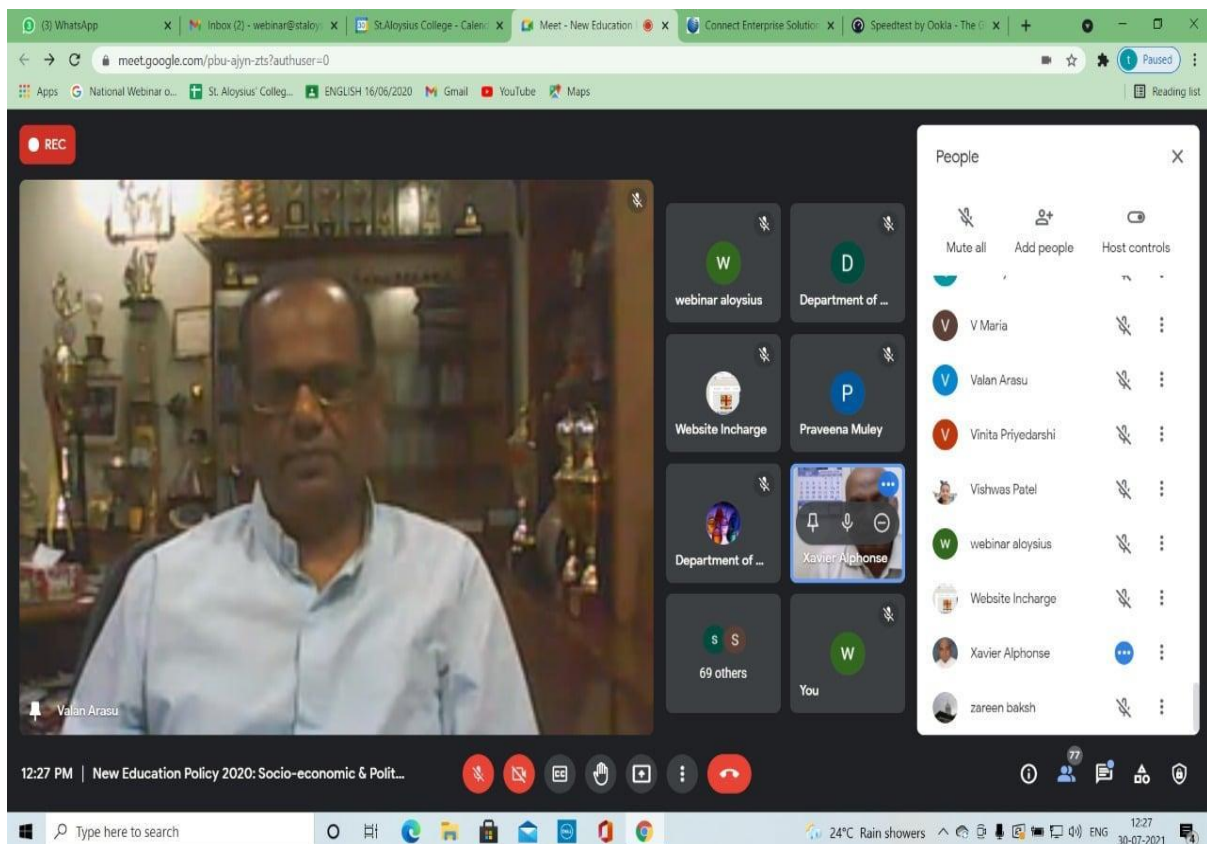
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National Conference on New Education Policy 2020: Socio-Economic & Political Implications

- ❖ Large affiliating universities resulting in low standards

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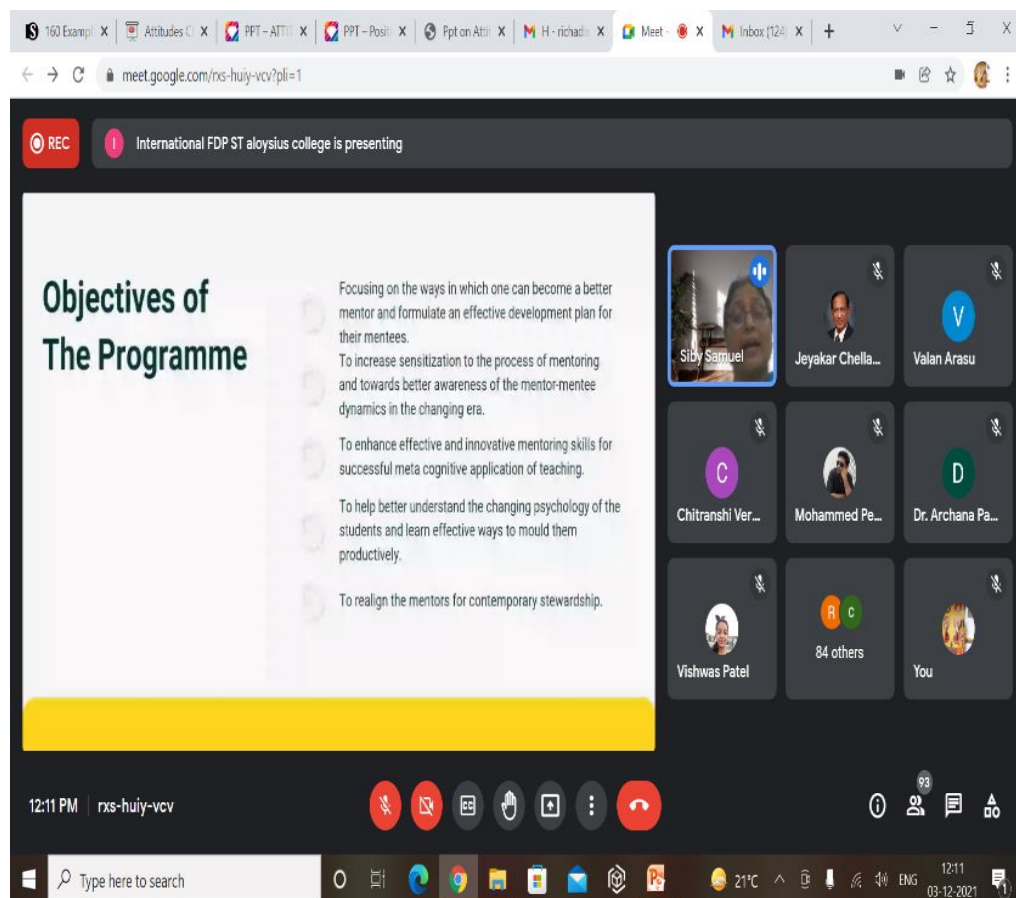
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Faculty Enrichment Programme on “Towards Enhanced Digitalization: Mentoring the Mentors”
